

## AMATEUR RADIO EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS NET

### *Amateur Radio Emergency Preparedness Net*

At 08:40 monitor your favorite Mega Link repeater and listen for activity. If no activity or if you can break into the activity before 08:45 say:

***"This is (your call) the net control for the Amateur Radio Emergency Preparedness Net. This net will begin at 09:00, in approximately 15 minutes from now on the New Mexico Mega Link frequencies. I will be taking early and short time check-ins for the net until that time. "***

At 9:00 am say:

***"This is (your call) my name is (your name) and I am located in (your location). I am the Amateur Radio Emergency Preparedness Net Control calling all Amateur Radio members, and any other interested amateurs. This net meets each Friday at 09:00 for the passing of information or instructions, the checking of equipment, the training of new Hams and evaluation of the statewide system. If anyone needs to use these frequencies for priority traffic, please feel free to call now or anytime during the net. This is a directed net.***

Pause a little while to see if anyone has any traffic.

***"Nothing heard we will proceed with a Roll-Call of regular members. Please wait for us to call you, then state whether you have traffic or comments. Please remember that this is a linked repeater system, so after keying the mic you should pause 1 to 2 seconds before speaking to allow all the repeaters in the system to key-up."***

Read the "Amateur Radio Emergency Preparedness Net" check-in list and mark those who check in.

***Say "This is (your call) net control for the Amateur Radio Emergency Preparedness Net" every 10 min. more or less.***

***"Having completed the Roll-Call we will proceed with general check-ins. When calling please check-in with your full call sign using ITU phonetics, followed by your name, and your location. Also please state whether you have traffic or comments for the net. Again please remember that this is a linked repeater system, so after keying the mic you should pause 1 to 2 seconds before speaking to allow all the repeaters in the system to key-up.***

*"All those with their suffixes beginning with the letters Alpha through Golf, please call now".*

*"All those with their suffixes beginning with the letters Hotel through Romeo, please call now".*

*"All those with their suffixes beginning with the letters Sierra through Zulu, please call now".*

*"This is (your call) the net control for the Amateur Radio Emergency Preparedness Net"*

*"A final call Alpha through Zulu, please call now".*

*"A final call for all interested amateur radio operators, please call now".*

Call back each check-in with indications of having traffic or comments.

*"Is there anyone desiring to talk to another station?"*

*"Is there any further business for the net today?"*

*"Nothing more heard the Amateur Radio Emergency Preparedness Net wishes to thank Paul Choc and the Mega Link for the use of their repeaters. Thank you all for checking in today. Amateur Radio Emergency Preparedness Net is secure as of (Time). This is (your call) and I'm clear of the network.*
